



## Visit Heritage Valley

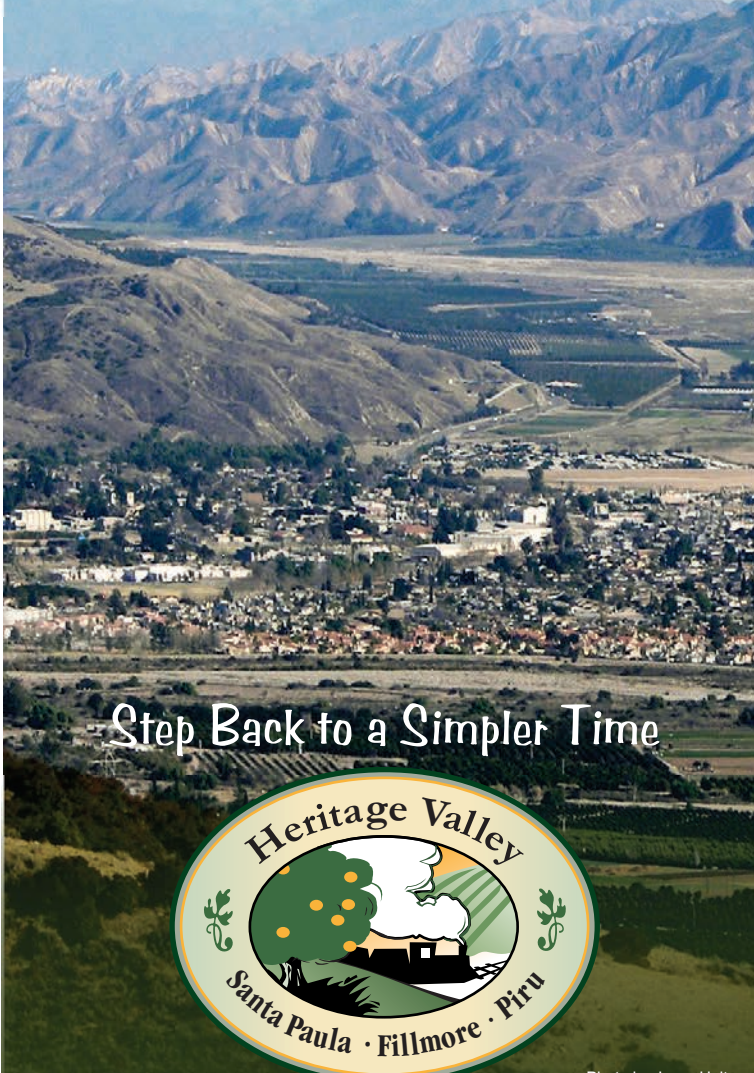

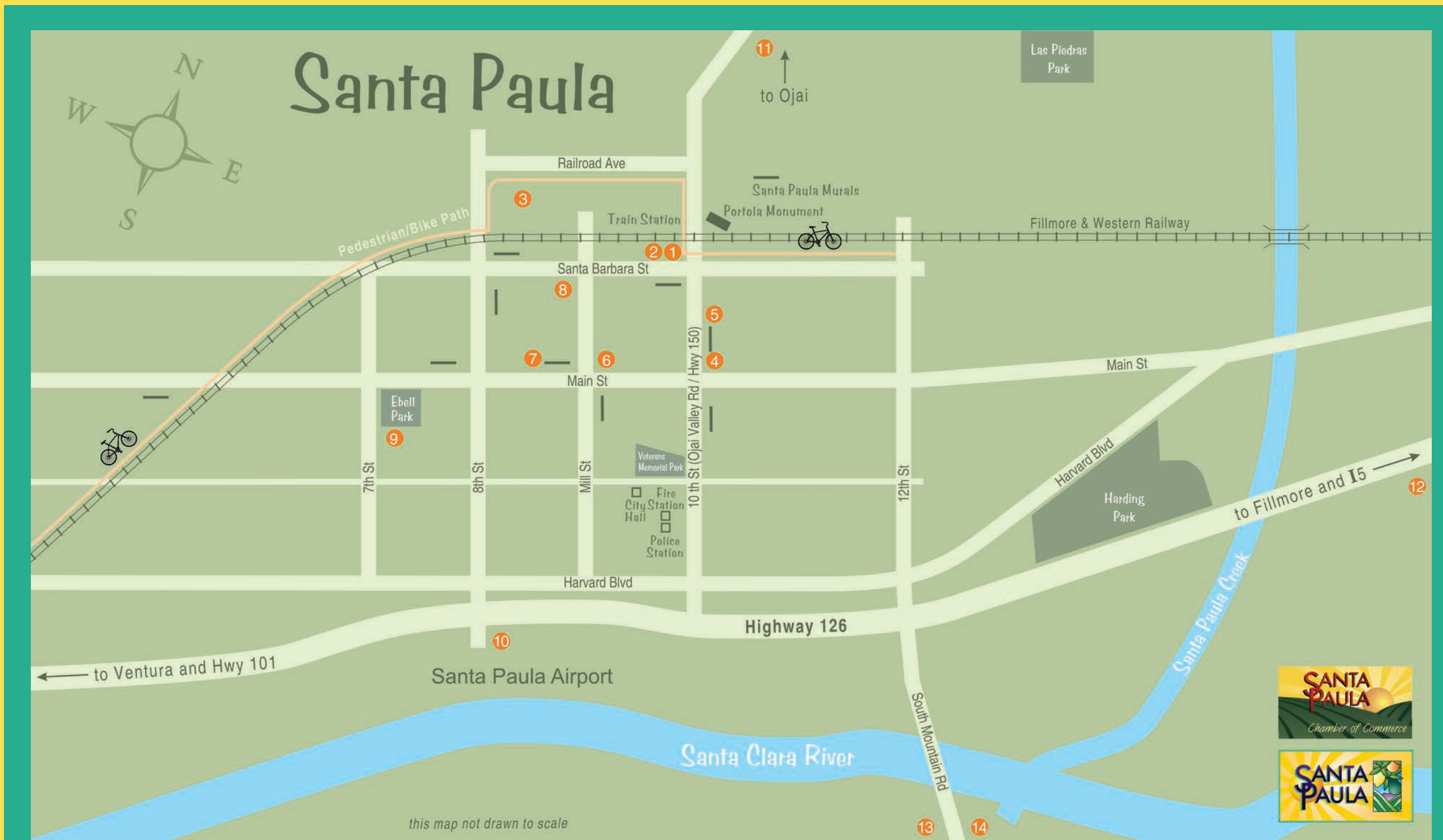
